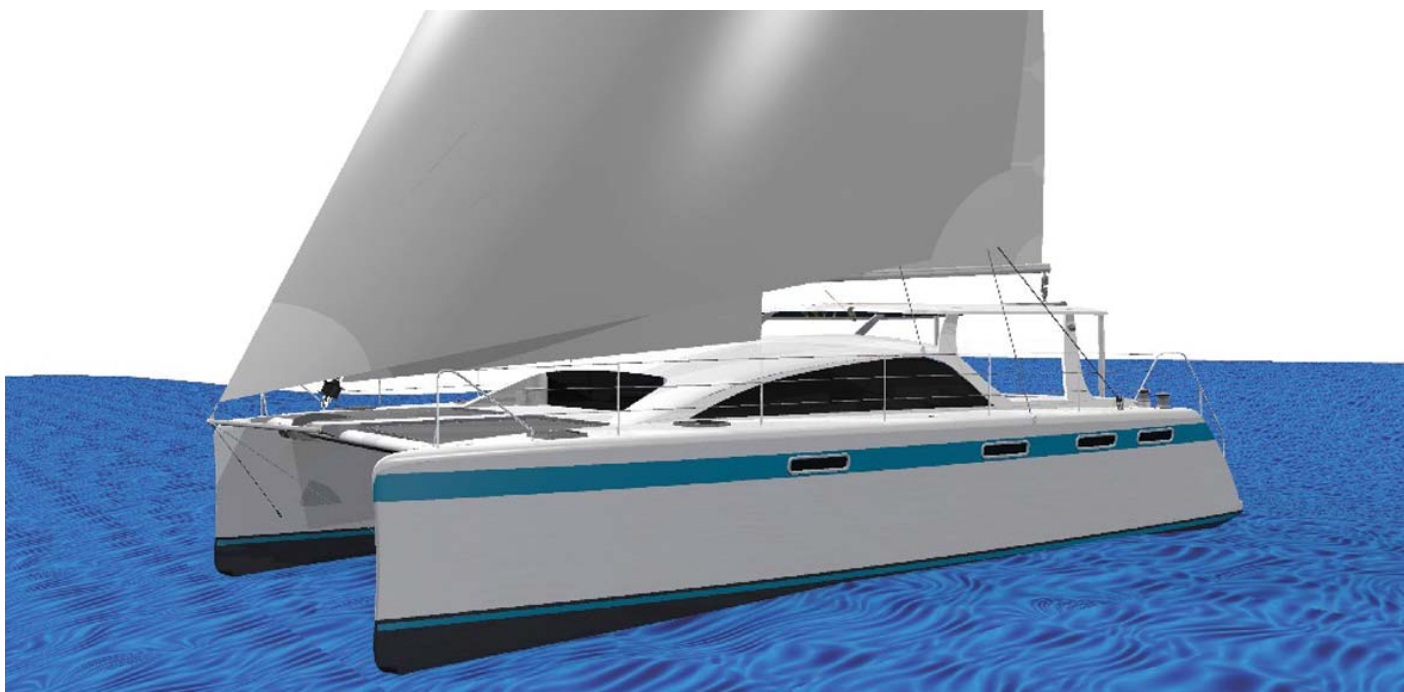


FREEFLOW 46 OPEN OCEAN SERIES

She has sweet sporting lines below the water and an aggressive stance above, and like all FreeFlow cats has revolutionised the amount of space and pace you can have in one catamaran.

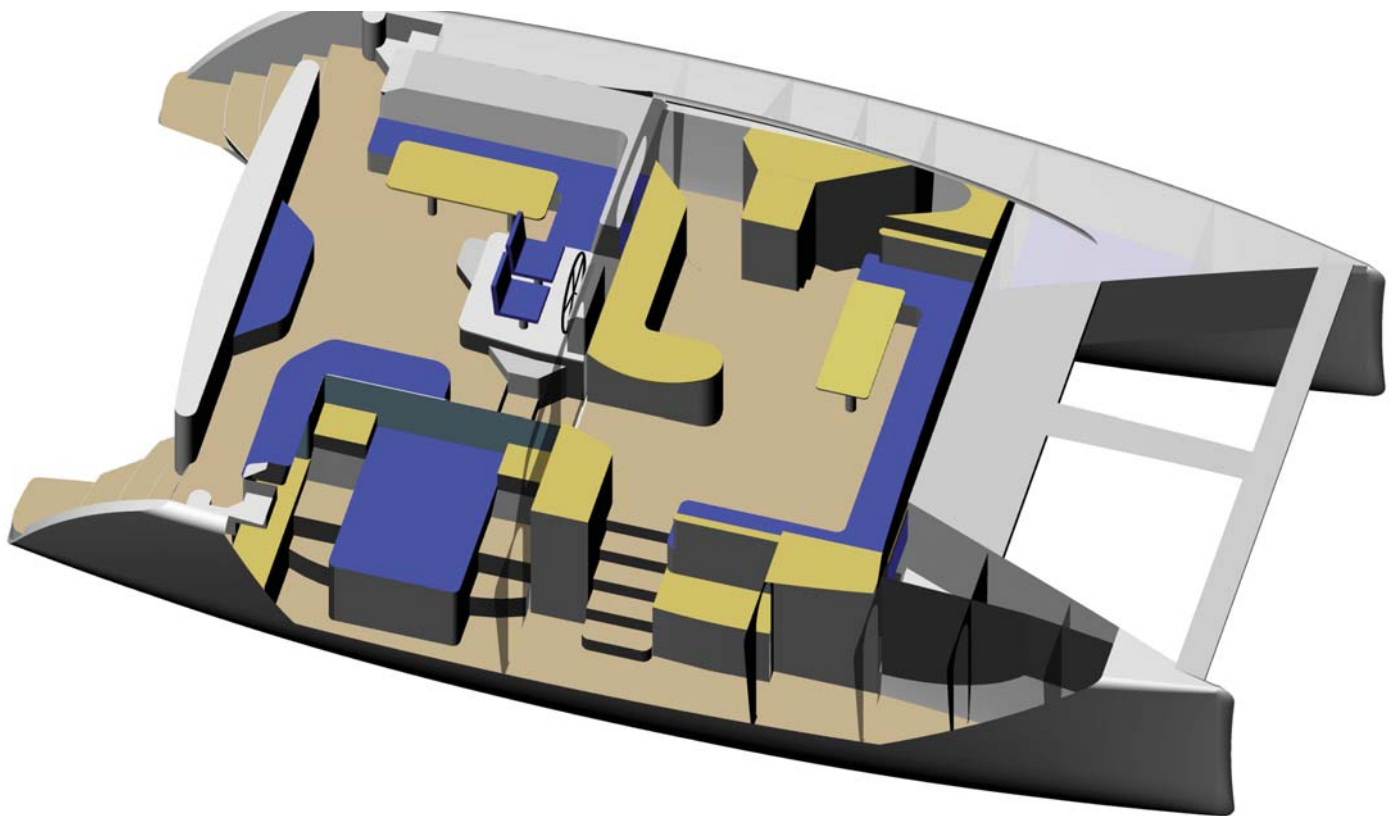
A basic list of what sets the FreeFlow 46 Open Ocean apart:

- Nine possible interior layouts to give you ideas;
- Huge live aboard 4.0m x 6m saloon;
- Centrally located galley up;
- Centralised weight for more comfort – less pitching – centralised engines and tankage allows finer low drag sections aft;
- Our low drag hull form enables a more conservative rig to achieve excellent performance with greater safety (less mast height also reduces pitching and cost);
- Mast in optimum central position;
- High freeboard for dry wide flat decks;
- High bridgedeck clearance – 950mm;
- Excellent payload capability – 8000kg-11900kg;
- Our trademark totally enclosable cockpit;
- Easy no stoop access to hulls;
- All foredeck and side decks on one flat plane;
- Ultra smooth/quiet engine installation system;
- Enormous 3.8m long cockpit;
- Seating for eight around the cockpit table;
- Queen size cockpit bed for tropical sleeping or day time relaxing;
- All lines from mast lead aft to helm position;
- Practical protected easy access helm station near the boats centre of gyration for maximum comfort, also at the centre of all social activity;
- Designed to fit neatly into a 14m multihull marina berth;
- **Parts set available for home or professional completion.**

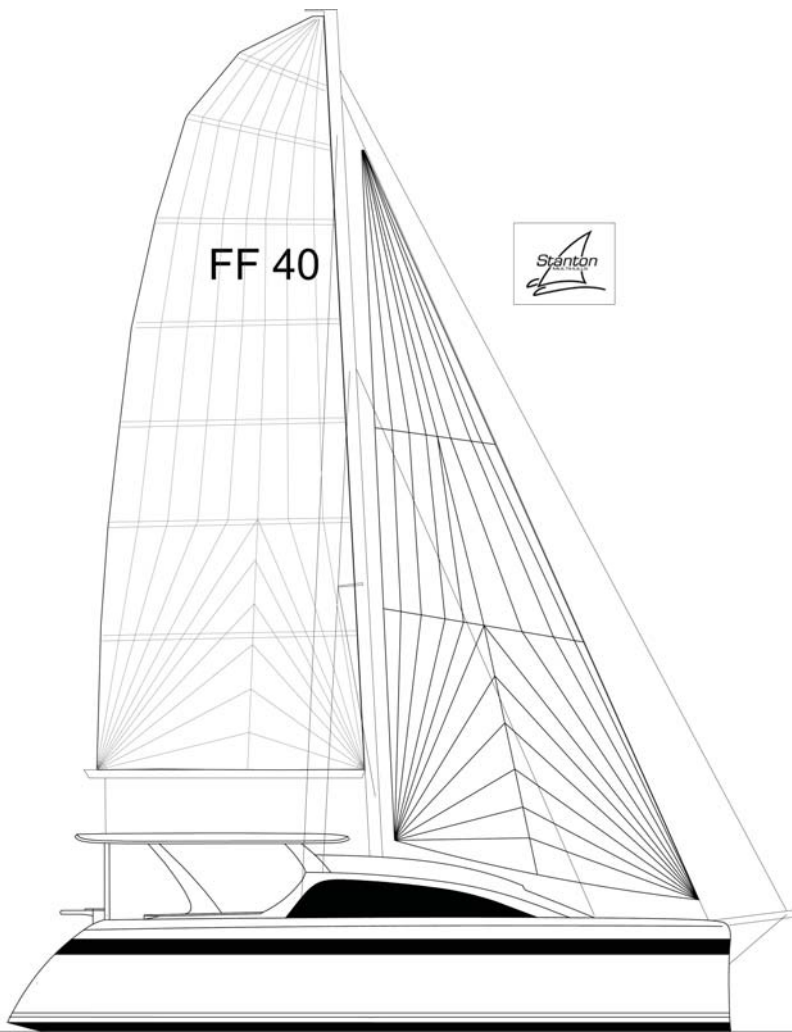

New for 2010

FreeFlow 40 is now on the drawing board. She is being designed like her bigger sister the 14m FreeFlow 46 to fit neatly into a standard sized marina berth in this case a 12m berth.

Following her pedigree she also offers more boat for your buck than any 40 footer with the space and pace to rival many larger cats in a compact and affordable size, whilst retaining the signature queen size island owner's berth and enormous living areas i.e. the saloon measures 3.4m fore and aft by 5.6m athwart ships. The cockpit is similarly well endowed with 3.3m fore and aft allowing ample room for a double helm seat, sun lounge and cockpit table with seating for six to eight people.

More design news

The new FreeFlow 8.5 folding system allows the boat to be folded in the water or on the trailer; so it can be stored in a standard mono marina berth or dry space.
